Melt chocolate chips and butterscotch chips together in microwave or double boiler. Stir in peanut butter and nuts. Stir in marshmallows after melted chips have cooled some. Marshmallows should not melt. Butter pan and spread mixture in pan. Cool in refrigerator until firm. Cut into bars.

STRAWBERRY CAKE (VERY RICH)

1 box white cake mix
1 sm. box strawberry Jello
3/4 c. Crisco oil
1 c. chopped nuts

2 c. strawberries, halved
3/4 c. milk
4 eggs, separated
1 c. shredded coconut

Frosting for Strawberry Cake:

1/2 stick margarine, softened
1 box powdered sugar

1/2 strawberry mixture

Combine cake mix and Jello. Mix together by hand. Add oil, milk and egg yolks; beat just enough to mix. In a separate bowl, mix coconut, nuts and strawberries. Put half of the mixture in batter; reserve the remaining half for frosting. Beat egg whites until stiff, but not dry. Fold into batter. Pour into 3 (8 or 9-inch) greased and floured cake pans. Bake 20 to 25 minutes at 350°. **Frosting for Strawberry Cake:** Cream margarine. Stir in powdered sugar. Add remaining strawberry mixture and beat well. Ice cooled cake.
