



PEACH UPSIDE DOWN CAKE

4 T. Oleo	4 T. Oleo
2 cups brown sugar	1 ¼ cup self rising flour
1 large can sliced peaches (drained)	½ cup milk
Batter:	1 egg
¾ cup sugar	1 tsp. vanilla

Make a syrup of the butter, and brown sugar. Arrange peach slices over the syrup in a heavy black skillet. Mix batter and pour over peaches. Bake about 40 minutes at 350 degrees. Best if served hot.

PEANUT BUTTER CAKE

1 Yellow cake mix	1 additional egg to the mix
Butter flavoring	

Mix yellow cake mix according to package directions, add extra egg and a little butter flavoring. Bake according to directions.

PEANUT BUTTER ICING

3 T peanut butter	1 can evaporated milk
1 box powdered sugar	vanilla
1 stick margarine	

Mix together, 1 stick softened margarine, 1 box powdered sugar, enough evaporated milk to desired consistency, add 3 heaping T. of peanut butter and a little vanilla. Let cake cool, then spread on icing.

Note: I don't use the whole box of powdered sugar, and I add a little more peanut butter. Adjust it to your own taste.
